<u>Luke 24:30</u> ¶ Now it came to pass, as He sat at the table with them, that He took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them.

<u>Luke 24:31</u> Then their eyes were opened and they knew Him; and He vanished from their sight.

<u>Luke 24:32</u> ¶ And they said to one another, "Did not our heart burn within us while He talked with us on the road, and while He opened the Scriptures to us?"

<u>Luke 24:33</u> So they rose up that very hour and returned to Jerusalem, and found the eleven and those *who were* with them gathered together,

Luke 24:34 saying, "The Lord is risen indeed, and has appeared to Simon!"

<u>Luke 24:35</u> And they told about the things *that had happened* on the road, and how He was known to them in the breaking of bread.

<u>Luke 24:36</u> ¶ Now as they said these things, the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled, for fear of the Jews

Jesus Himself [came and] stood in the midst of them, and said to them, "Peace to you." Shalom Aleikem

<u>Luke 24:37</u> But they were terrified and frightened, and supposed they had seen a spirit.

<u>Luke 24:38</u> And He said to them, "Why are you troubled? And why do doubts arise in your hearts?

<u>Luke 24:39</u> He said, "Behold My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself. Handle Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see I have."

<u>Luke 24:40</u> ¶ When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His feet and His side.

Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord.

<u>Luke 24:41</u> But while they still did not believe for joy, and marveled, He said to them, "Have you any food here?"

Luke 24:42 So they gave Him a piece of a broiled fish and some honeycomb.

<u>Luke 24:43</u> And He took *it* and ate in their presence.

<u>Luke 24:44</u> ¶ Then He said to them, "These *are* the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and *the* Prophets and *the* Psalms concerning Me."

<u>Luke 24:45</u> And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures.

<u>John 20:21</u> \P So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."

<u>John 20:22</u> And when He had said this, He breathed on *them*, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit.

<u>John 20:23</u> If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the *sins* of any, they are retained."

<u>John 20:24</u> ¶ Now Thomas, called the Twin, one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came.

<u>John 20:25</u> The other disciples therefore said to him, "We have seen the Lord." ¶ So he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe."
