





Doctrine of Regeneration

Regeneration is a technical term derived from the Greek:

paliggenesia: 2x Titus 3:5; Matt. 19:28 ἀναγεννάω, anagennao, 1 Pet. 1:3, 23

gennao anothen: lit. born again or born from above. John 3:3, 7

Gennaw ahwgen, gennao anothen Born again, or from above, John 3:3, 5 paliggennesia, palingennesia Born again, Titus 3:5 ahagennaw, anagennao, Born again 1 Pet. 1:3, 23

suzwopoiew, suzoopoieo Made alive together, Eph. 4:5,

Spiritual birth, or being "born again." At the moment a person expresses faith alone in Christ alone the Holy Spirit creates a human spirit and God the Father simultaneously imputes eternal life to the human spirit and the believer passes from spiritual death to spiritual life (John 3:3-7; Titus 3:5).

The Three Parts of a Human Being: Body, Soul, and Spirit



1 Cor. 2:12, "Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit who is from God [ek tou theou], that we might know the things freely given to us by God,"

1 Cor. 2:13, "which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the Spirit, combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words."

1 Cor. 2:14, "But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God; for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised."

Jude 19, "These are the ones who cause divisions, worldly-minded [psuchikos, soulish], [literally, not having a spirit]."

1 Thess. 5:23, "Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ." John 3:1, "Now there was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews;

John 3:2, "this man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, 'Rabbi, we know that You have come from God as a teacher; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him.'"

John 3:3, "Jesus answered and said to him, 'Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God.'

John 3:4, "Nicodemus said to Him, 'How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born, can he?' "


John 3:5, "Jesus answered, 'Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

John 3:6, "That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit."

Titus 3:5, "He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit,"

Eph. 2:4, "But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us,

Eph. 2:5, "even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved),"
