



Contents of chapter 49:

Genesis 35:22–26 (cf. 29:31–30:24): The Sons of Jacob (Israel)











- Isaiah 11:1 "Then a shoot will spring from the stem of Jesse, and a <u>branch</u> from his roots will bear fruit."



The translation "to whom it belongs" may come from the Hebrew relative pronoun (se), a preposition (le), and a pronominal suffix (oh), translated "who to him," or "to whom it belongs."

"he whose it is, that which belongs to him; tranquility, rest"
