Hope and Endurance Romans 5:3–5



Rom. 5:2, "through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope (confidence) of the glory of God.

Rom. 5:3, "And not only that, but we also rejoice (glory, NJV) in adversities, (because we) knowing that adversity produces endurance;

Rom. 5:4, "and endurance, character; and character, confidence (hope).

Rom. 5:5, "Now hope (confidence in God) does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us."

The Doctrine of the Believer's Hope

A summary

Hope is not a fruit of the Spirit, but is a <u>mental</u> <u>attitude</u> developed in the believer through the application of Scripture so that we can endure through trials.

Hope is based on a past promise of a future reality.

Hope provides the believer with confidence in future reality so certain that it strengthens and toughens the believer's mentality today to face, fight, and surmount unpleasant circumstances with a mentality of joy in the midst of difficulty.

2 Cor. 4:6, "For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ."

Titus 1:2, "in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began,"

Titus 3:7, "that having been justified by His grace we should become heirs <u>according to the hope of eternal life</u>."

Titus 2:13, "looking for the <u>blessed hope and</u> glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,"
