Pattern for Prayer

Matthew 6:9

Pope Francis prays the “Our Father” at the wall separating Israel from the Palestinian territories.



Didache 8:2, “Nor should you pray like the hypocrites. Instead, ‘pray like this,’ just as the Lord commanded in his Gospel:

**Our Father in heaven,
hallowed be your name,
your kingdom come,
your will be done
on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us today our daily bread,
and forgive us our debt,
as we also forgive our debtors;
and do not lead us into temptation,
but deliver us from the evil one;²⁷
for yours is the power and the glory forever.²⁸**

One of Jacob, and fear the God of Israel.”**

**Ezek. 36:23, “ ‘And I will sanctify My great
name, which has been profaned among the
nations, which you have profaned in their
midst; and the nations shall know that I am
the LORD,’ says the Lord GOD, ‘when I am
hallowed in you before their eyes.’ ”**
