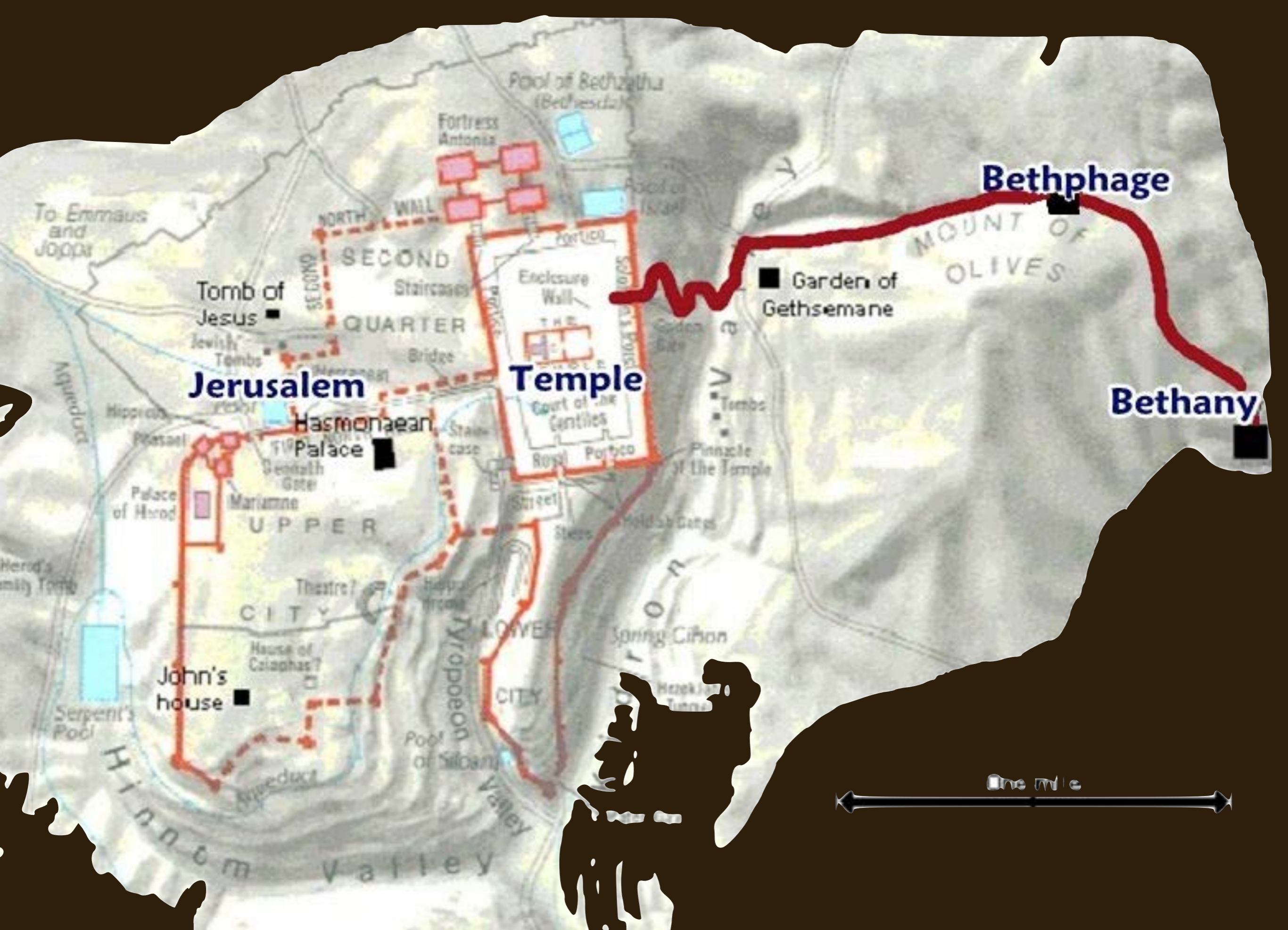
Donkey at Bethphage

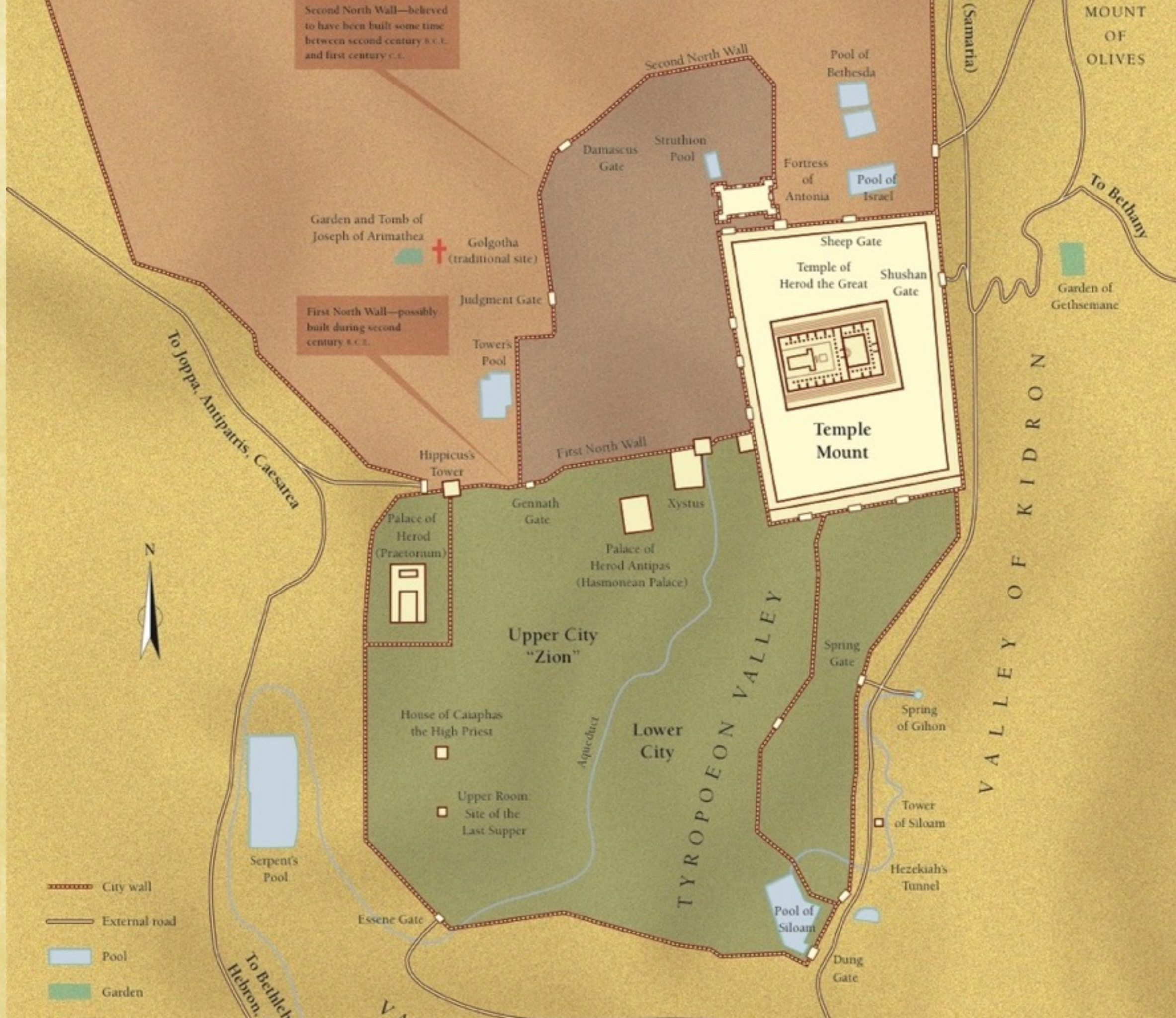

“Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, and the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.

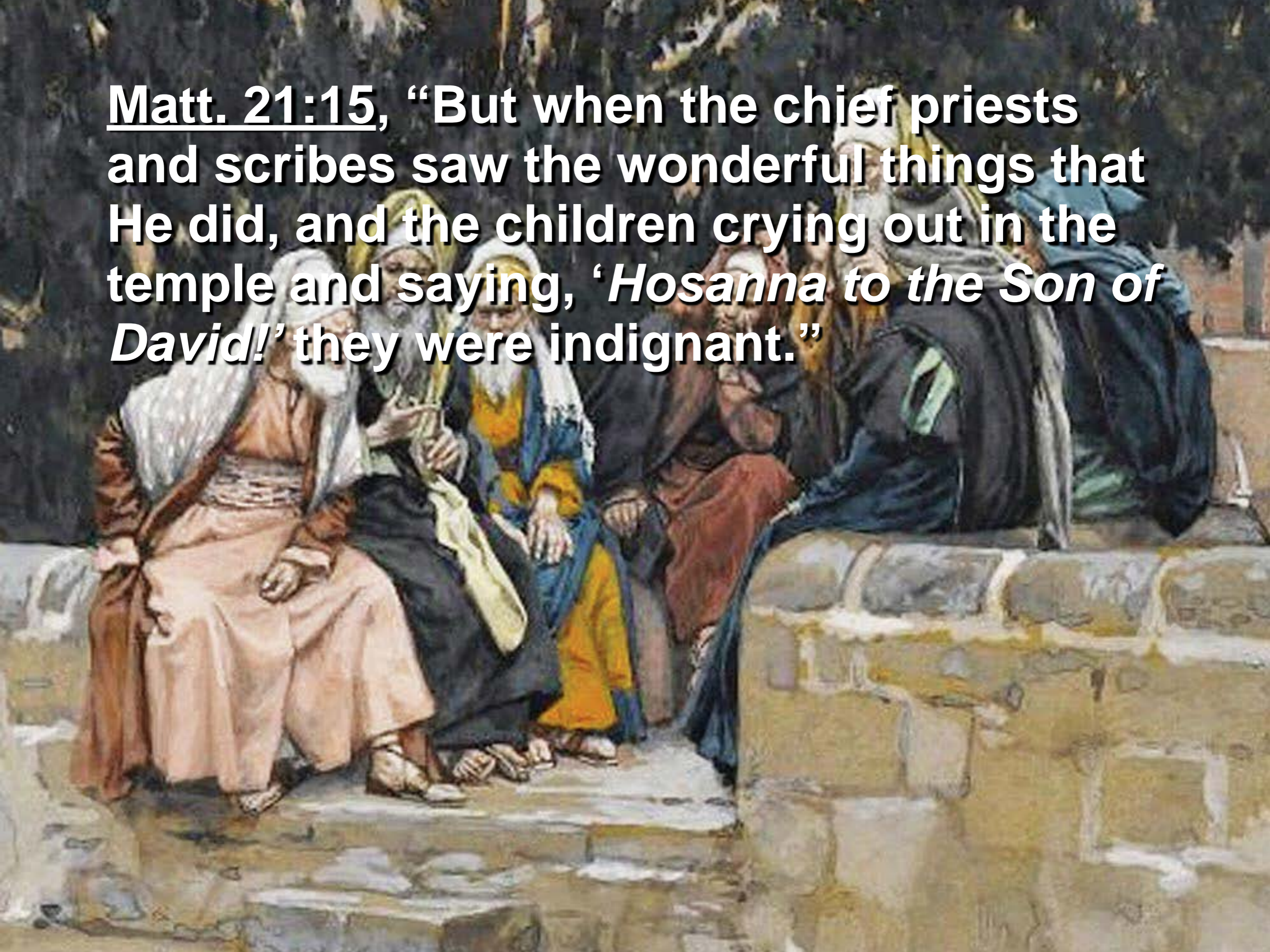
