

Revelation

General Revelation: the nonverbal disclosure from God as contained in His works of creation and providence, i.e., the universe, a molecule, a flower, the design of a giraffe's brain.

Psa. 19:2, "Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night reveals knowledge.

Psa. 19:3, "There is no speech nor language where their voice is not heard.

Revelation

General Revelation: the nonverbal disclosure from God as contained in His works of creation and providence, i.e., the universe, a molecule, a flower, the design of a giraffe's brain.

Special Revelation: the direct, verbal self-disclosure of God to His creatures, i.e., a theophany, the Scriptures, non-recorded verbal communication to mankind.


