1. Contrite

דָּכָא (dākā) **be crushed, contrite, broken**

Psa. 34:18, “The LORD is near to those who have a broken heart, and saves such as have a contrite spirit.”

Humble

שָׁפַל (*shāpēl*) **be low, sink, be humbled**

Psa. 138:6, “Though the LORD is on high, yet He regards the lowly; But the proud He knows from afar.”

Prov. 29:23, “A man’s pride will bring him low, but the humble in spirit will retain honor.”

Prov. 3:34, “Surely He scorns the scornful, but gives grace to the humble.”

1 Pet. 5:5, “Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for ‘God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble.’ ”

1 Pet. 5:6, “Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time,

1 Pet. 5:7, [by] “casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.”
