

Staircase to Maturity

Indwelling of Christ

Rom. 8:10, "And if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness."

- 2 Cor. 13:3, "since you seek a proof of Christ speaking in me, who is not weak toward you, but mighty in you."
- 2 Cor. 13:5, "Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?—unless indeed you are disqualified."

Indwelling of Christ

Gal. 2:20, "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."

Col. 1:27, "To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory."

John 15:4, "Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

John 15:5, "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

John 15:6, "If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned.

John 15:7, "If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you."
