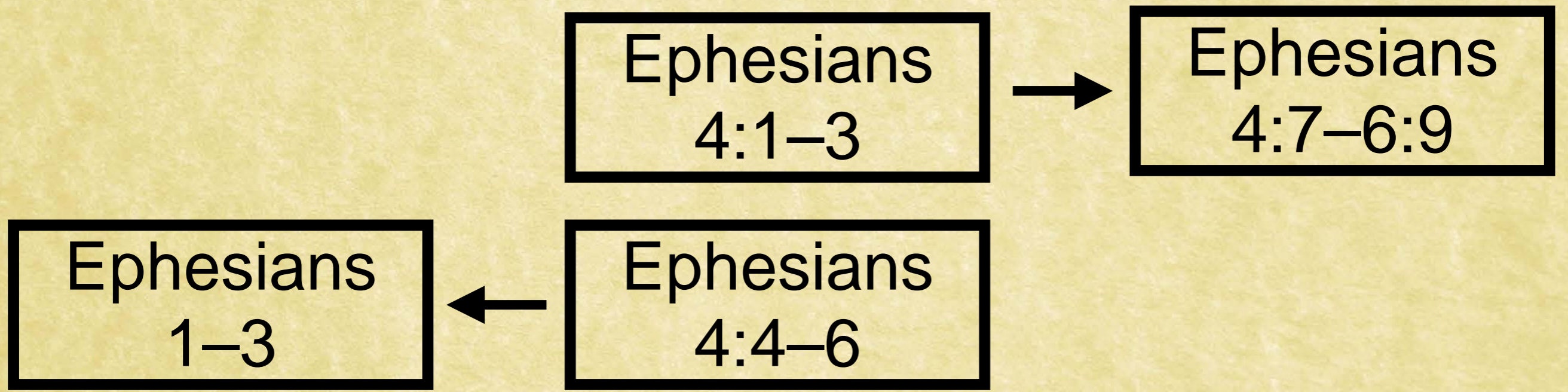

**“The Called”: Our Identity in Christ
Ephesians 4:1**

Eph. 4:1, “I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called,”

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Eph. 3:1, “For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for you Gentiles—”

Eph. 4:1, “I, Paul, a prisoner in Christ” [ἐν κυρίῳ *en kurio*],

Eph. 3:1, “Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for you Gentiles” [ὁ δέσμιος τοῦ Χριστοῦ Ἰησοῦ [*του Christou Iesou*]
