

Deut. 6:4, "Hear O Israel, the Lord our God is One." ~NKJV

Deut. 6:4, "Hear, O Israel, the Lord is our God, the Lord alone." ~Tanakh, 1986

Isa. 48:15, "I, even I, have spoken; indeed I have called him, I have brought him, and He will make his ways successful.

Isa. 48:16, "Come near to Me, listen to this: From the first I have not spoken in secret, from the time it took place, I was there. And now the Lord GOD has sent Me, and His Spirit."

Isaiah 9:6, "For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father [Father of eternity], Prince of Peace."

ἄλλος *allos* Adjective masc sing acc (demonstrative) "other, another of the same kind, otherwise"




1 Pet. 1:2, "elect according to the foreknowledge of <u>God the Father</u>, in sanctification of the <u>Spirit</u>, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of <u>Jesus Christ</u>:"

Father is the planner, the architect.

Son is the one who carries out the plan of salvation.

The Holy Spirit is the one who reveals the plan, and works in the believer for spiritual growth.





1 Pet. 1:2, "elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ:"

ἀγιασμός hagiasmos Noun masc sing dative literally: "setting apart" sanctification, consecration. The setting apart of the believer to the service of God through spiritual growth.

Rom. 3:23, "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,"

oὐ μὴ *ou m*e with the subjunctive verb You will not be able to, impossible to do something. You will be unable to bring to completion the lust of the flesh.

The Constant Struggle

Gal. 5:17, "For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish."

Active voice imperative is directed to our volition, we are to choose to obey the command.

But a passive voice command means we let something happen to us, or receive something.

Eph. 5:18, "And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit,"
