

Ethics: What is right? What is wrong? What is good or bad?


Epistemology (Knowledge):

The Great Chain of Being in History

1. A hierarchy of static, unchanging forms, with god (Being, Unmoved Mover, the Good, the Absolute, etc.) at the top, then angels, humans, animals, plants, down to inanimate objects. Each had its place. The movement is from the top down and the forms are unchanging.

"Apart from biblically governed thought, the prevailing concept of being has been that being is one and continuous. 



Gen. 1:12, "And the earth brought forth grass, the herb that yields seed according to its kind, and the tree that yields fruit, whose seed is in itself according to its kind. And God saw that it was good."

Gen. 1:21, "So God created great sea creatures and every living thing that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good."

Gen. 1:24, "Then God said, 'Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind: cattle and creeping thing and beast of the earth, each according to its kind'; and it was so. Gen. 1:25, "And God made the beast of the earth according to its kind, cattle according to its kind, and everything that creeps on the earth according to its kind. Rom. 8:29, "For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the <u>image of His Son</u>, that He might be the first-born among many brethren;"

1 Cor. 15:49, "And just as we have borne the <u>image of the</u> earthy, we shall also bear the <u>image of the heavenly</u>."

2 Cor. 3:18, "But we all, with unveiled face beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit."

Col. 3:10, "and have put on the new self who is being renewed to a true knowledge according to the image of the One who created him,"

When God made humanity, male and female, both were equally in the image and likeness of God, BUT ...

each had a different role, and so male and female were designed physically, soulishly, and spiritually to be adapted for their role.

Gen. 2:18, "And the Lord God said, 'It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him.' " ~NKJV

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Gen. 2:20, "So Adam gave names to all cattle, to the birds of the air, and to every beast of the field. But for Adam there was not found a helper comparable to him."

<u>Deut. 33:29</u>, "Happy are you, O Israel! Who is like you, a people saved by the LORD, the shield of your <u>help</u> and the sword of your majesty! Your enemies shall submit to you, and you shall tread down their high places."

Psa. 70:5, "But I am poor and needy; Make haste to me, O God! You are my help and my deliverer; O LORD, do not delay."

Hos. 13:9, "O Israel, you are destroyed, but your <u>help</u> is from Me."

Psa. 121:2, "My help comes from the LORD, Who made heaven and earth."

Psa. 124:8, "Our help is in the name of the LORD, Who made heaven and earth."

Psa. 146:5, "Happy is he who has the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the LORD his God,"

The current argument:

- Men and women are equal and interchangeable.
- If they are interchangeable, then they are the same, no barriers exist.
- To assert that males and females are equal in the sense of interchangeability, denies that which is of their essence, and thus destroys their significance.
- By changing something's essence, you change what it is, and in this case destroy its value.

"'I should like Balls infinitely better', said Caroline Bingley, 'if they were carried on in a different manner ... It would surely be much more rational if conversation instead of dancing made the order of the day.' 'Much more rational, I dare say,' replied her brother, 'but it would not be near so much like a Ball.'"

His argument:

- A Ball is by definition having the essence of dancing.
- To change the essence from dancing to conversation is to render it no longer a Ball.
- By analogy:
 - The essence of the [Anglican] Church, biblically speaking, is to be led by a priest, to change to a priestess renders it something other than a biblical church.
 - Admitting women to the priesthood would be so revolutionary the church would no longer be the church, an essential characteristic had been changed.

Two Key Questions:

- Are men and women equal?
- Are men and women interchangeable?
