Rom. 8:21, “because the creation itself also will be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God.

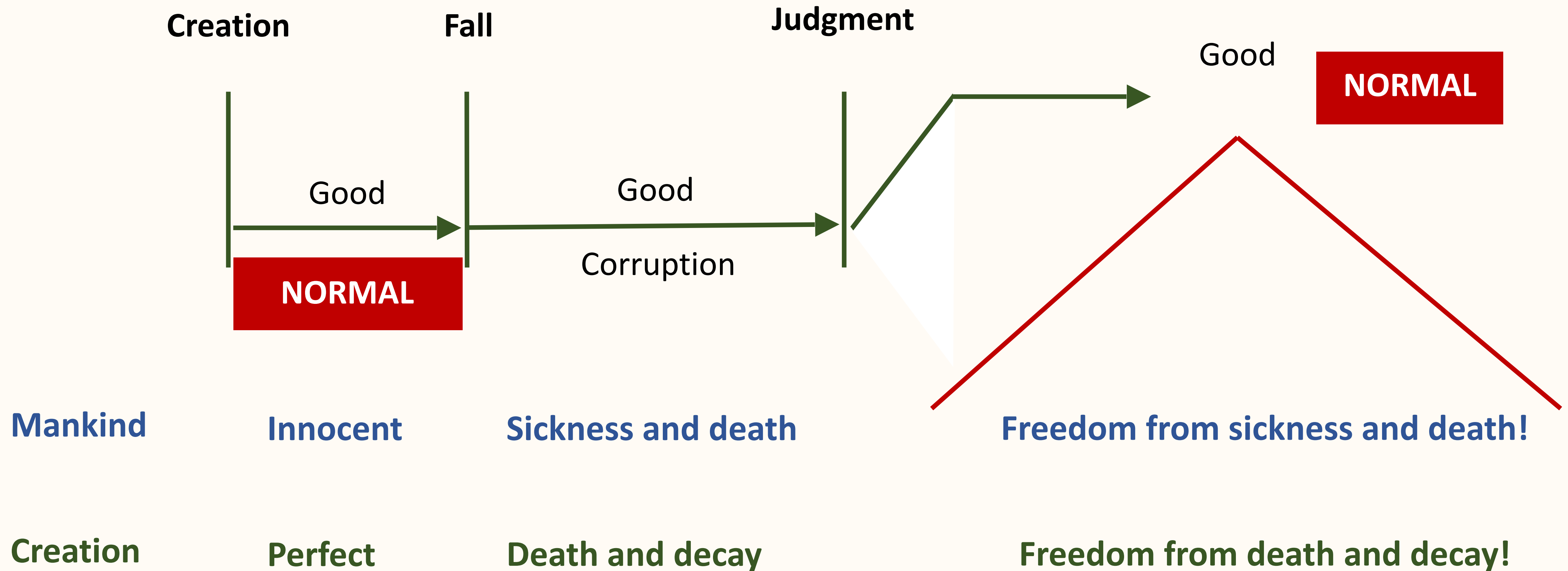
Rom. 8:22, “For we know that the whole creation groans and labors with birth pangs together until now.

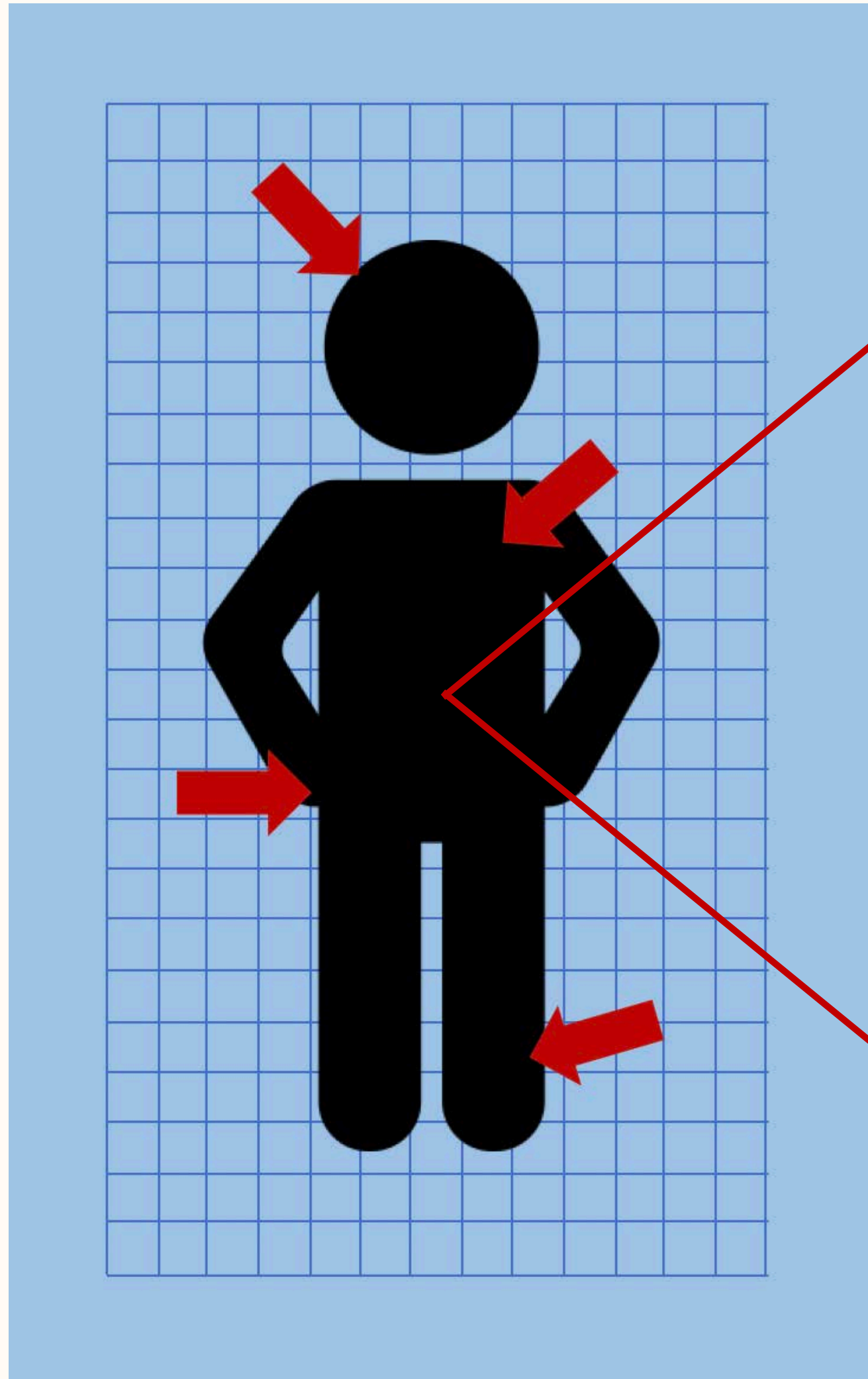

Gen. 2:18, “And the LORD God said, ‘It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him.’ ”

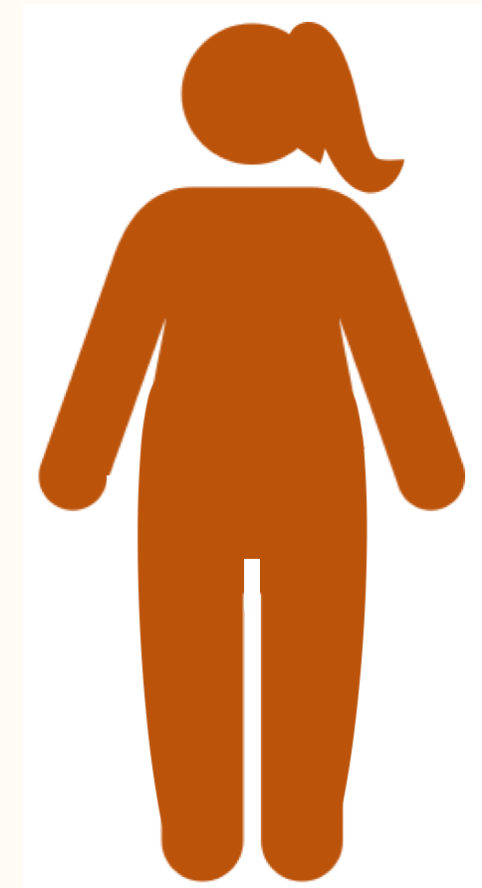
Gen. 2:21, “And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall on Adam, and he slept; and He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh in its place.

“JUST RIGHT” = Woman

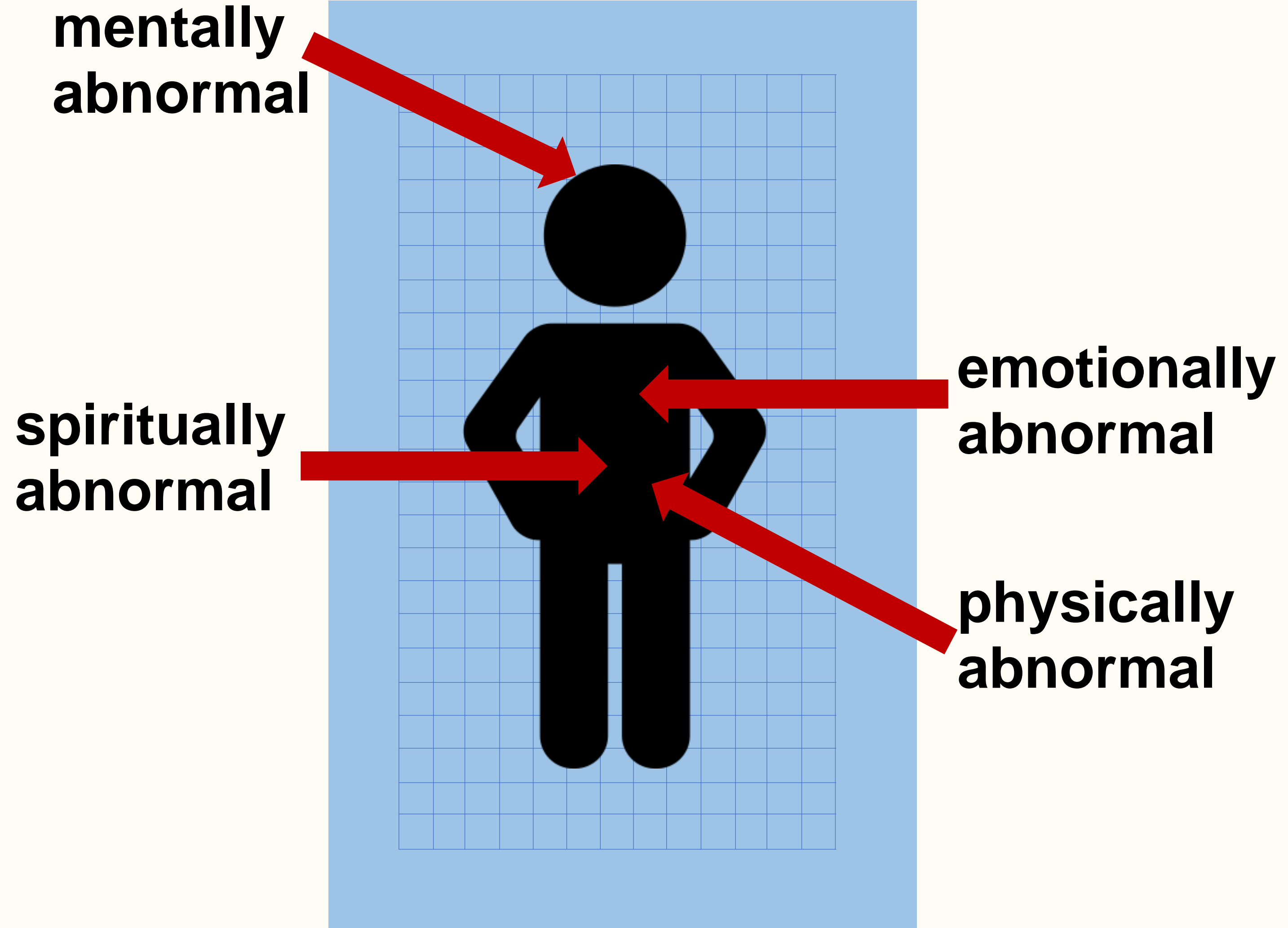
Gen. 2:22, “Then the rib which the LORD God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man.

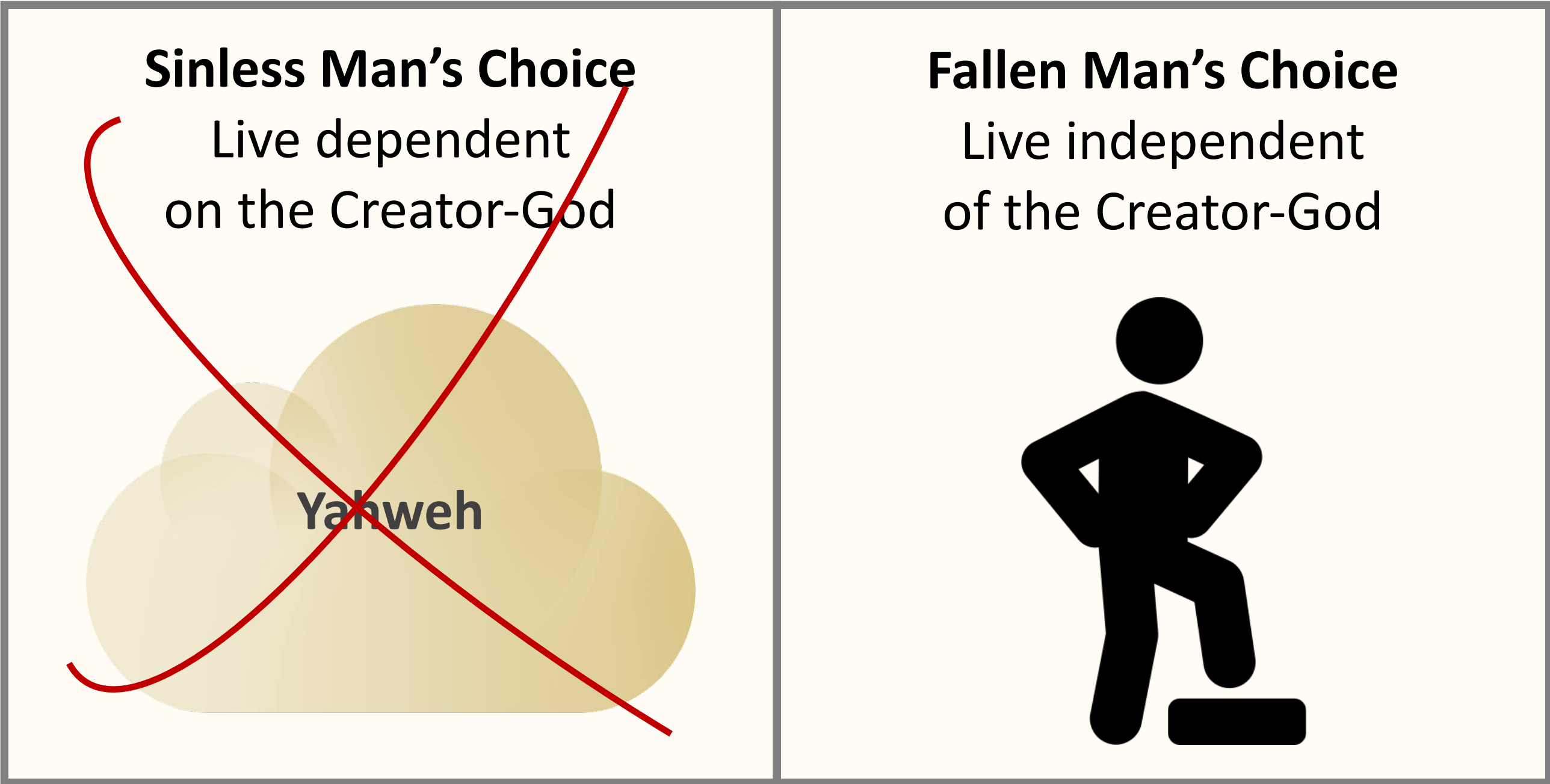

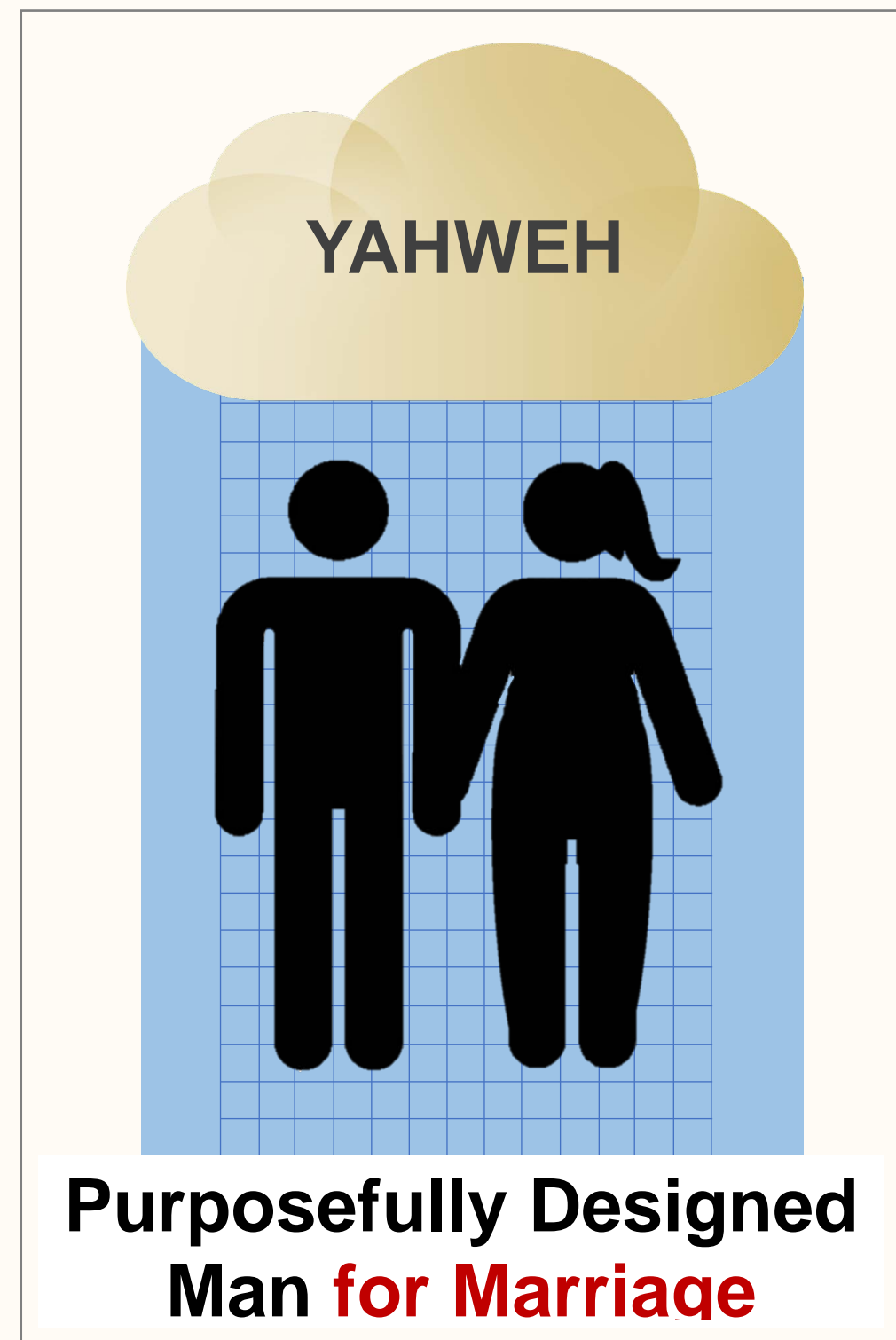

1 st level	CREATOR	→	God's Revelation
2 nd level	creature	→	man's ideas

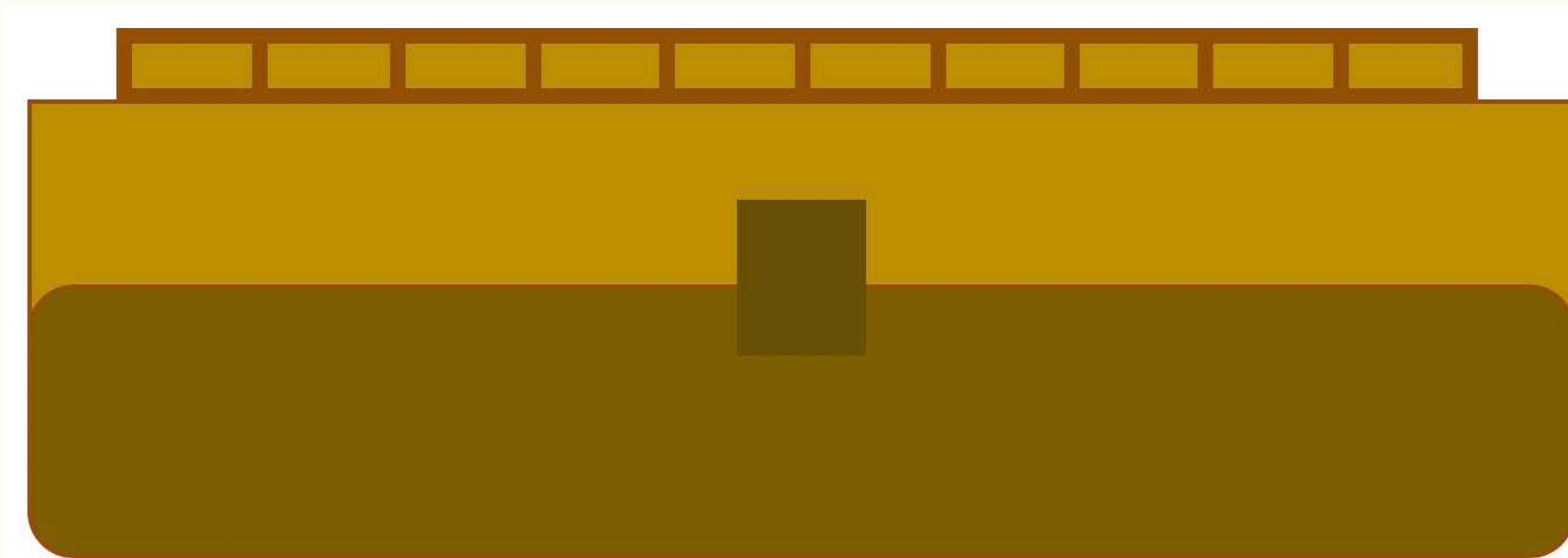
3. The belief that technology is evil

A. Noah's knowledge of vineyards and wine-making and his lapse into drunkenness and nakedness.

Gen. 6:14, “Make yourself an ark of gopherwood; make rooms in the ark, and cover it inside and outside with pitch.

Gen. 6:15, “And this is how you shall make it: The length of the ark shall be three hundred cubits, its width fifty cubits, and its height thirty cubits.

Gen. 6:16, “You shall make a window for the ark, and you shall finish it to a cubit from above; and set the door of the ark in its side. You shall make it with lower, second, and third decks.”

and he planted a vineyard.



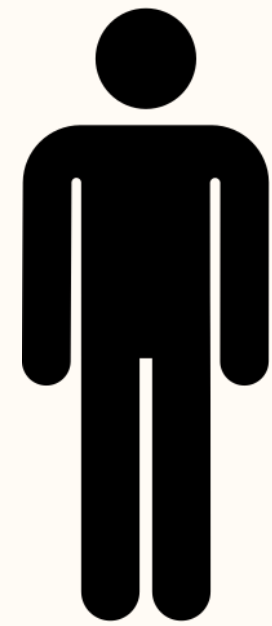
Gen. 9:21, “Then he drank of the wine

Psa. 78:4, “We will not hide them from their children, telling to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, and His strength and His wonderful works that He has done.

Psa. 78:5, “For He established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which He commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children;

Psa. 78:6, “That the generation to come might know them, the children who would be born, that they may arise and declare them to their children,

Psa. 78:7, “That they may set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep His commandments;

Psa. 78:8, “And may not be like their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation, a generation that did not set its heart aright, and whose spirit was not faithful to God.”

i. However, before training children, parents are to first obey God's commandments themselves.



Parents must:

i. First obey God themselves

ii. Model godly behavior

iii. Not be unreasonable

Eph. 6:4, “And you, fathers, do not provoke your children to wrath, but bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord.”

Titus 2:6, “Likewise, exhort the young men to be sober-minded,

Titus 2:7, “in all things showing yourself to be a pattern of good works; in doctrine showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility,

Titus 2:8, “sound speech that cannot be condemned, that one who is an opponent may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of you.”

Col. 3:21, “Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged.”

Ex. 20:12, “Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the LORD your God is giving you.”

Eph. 6:1, “Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

Eph. 6:2, “ ‘Honor your father and mother,’ which is the first commandment with promise:

Eph. 6:3, “ ‘that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth.’ ”

1 Cor. 13:6, “does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth;

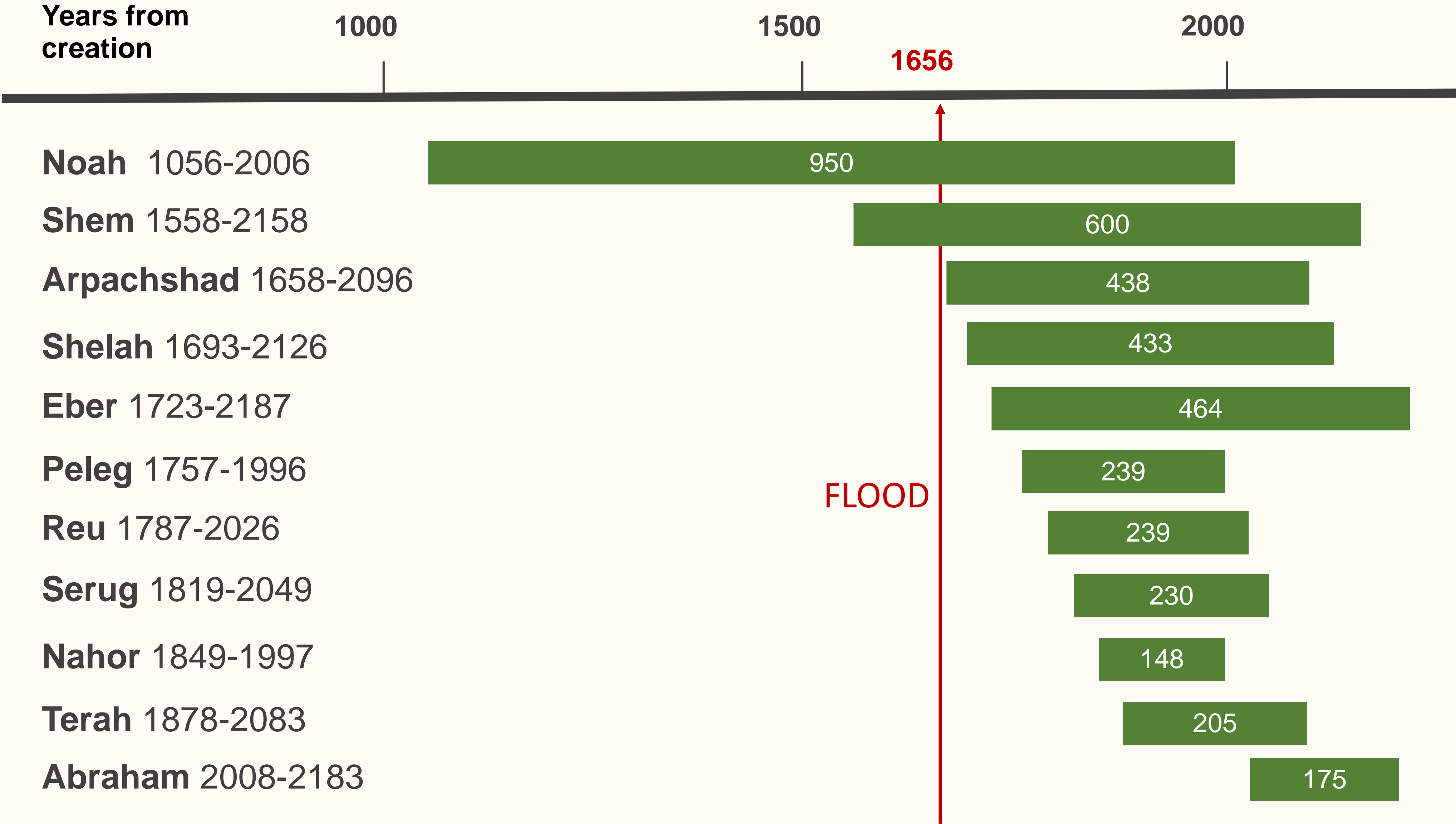

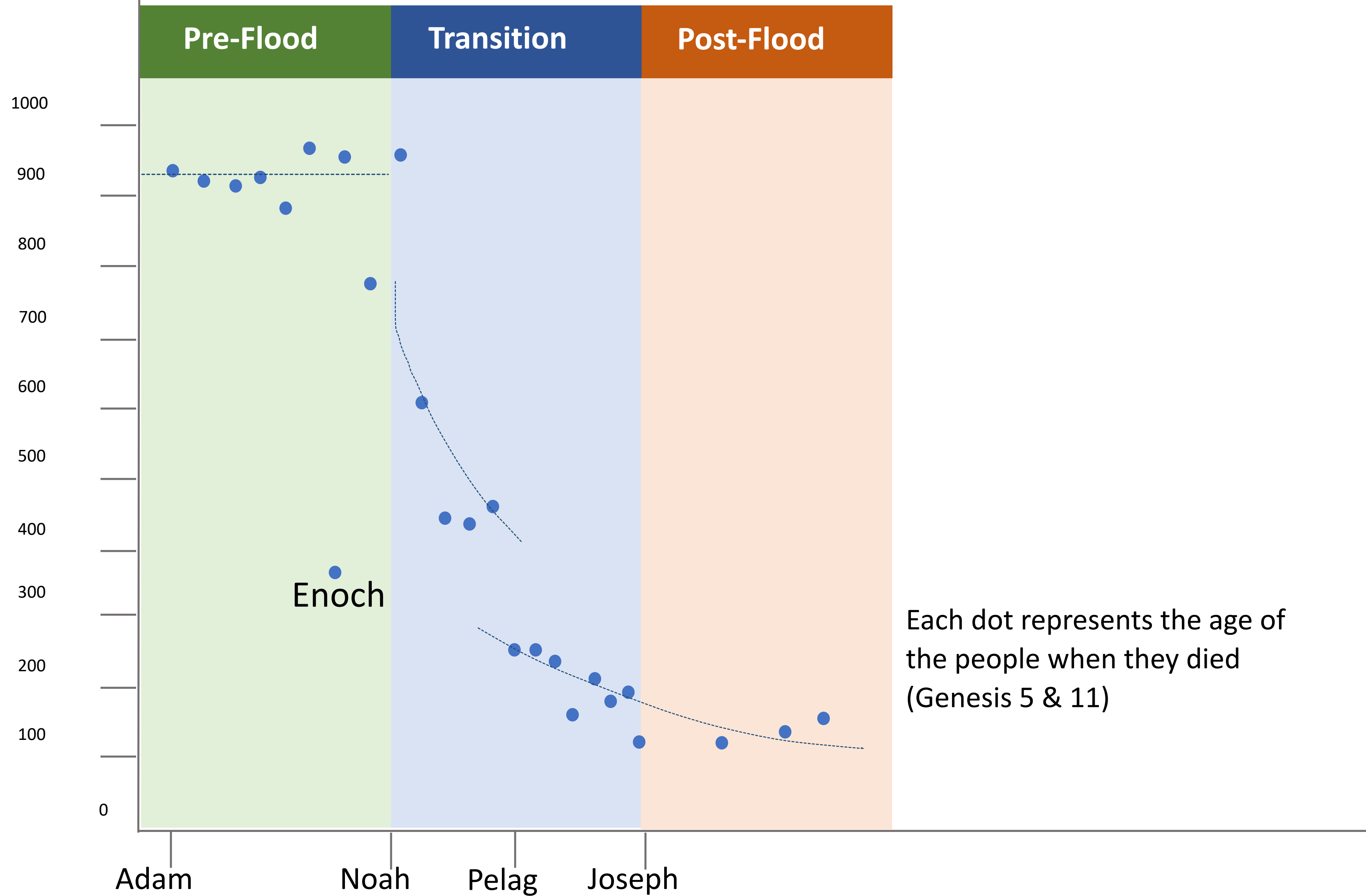

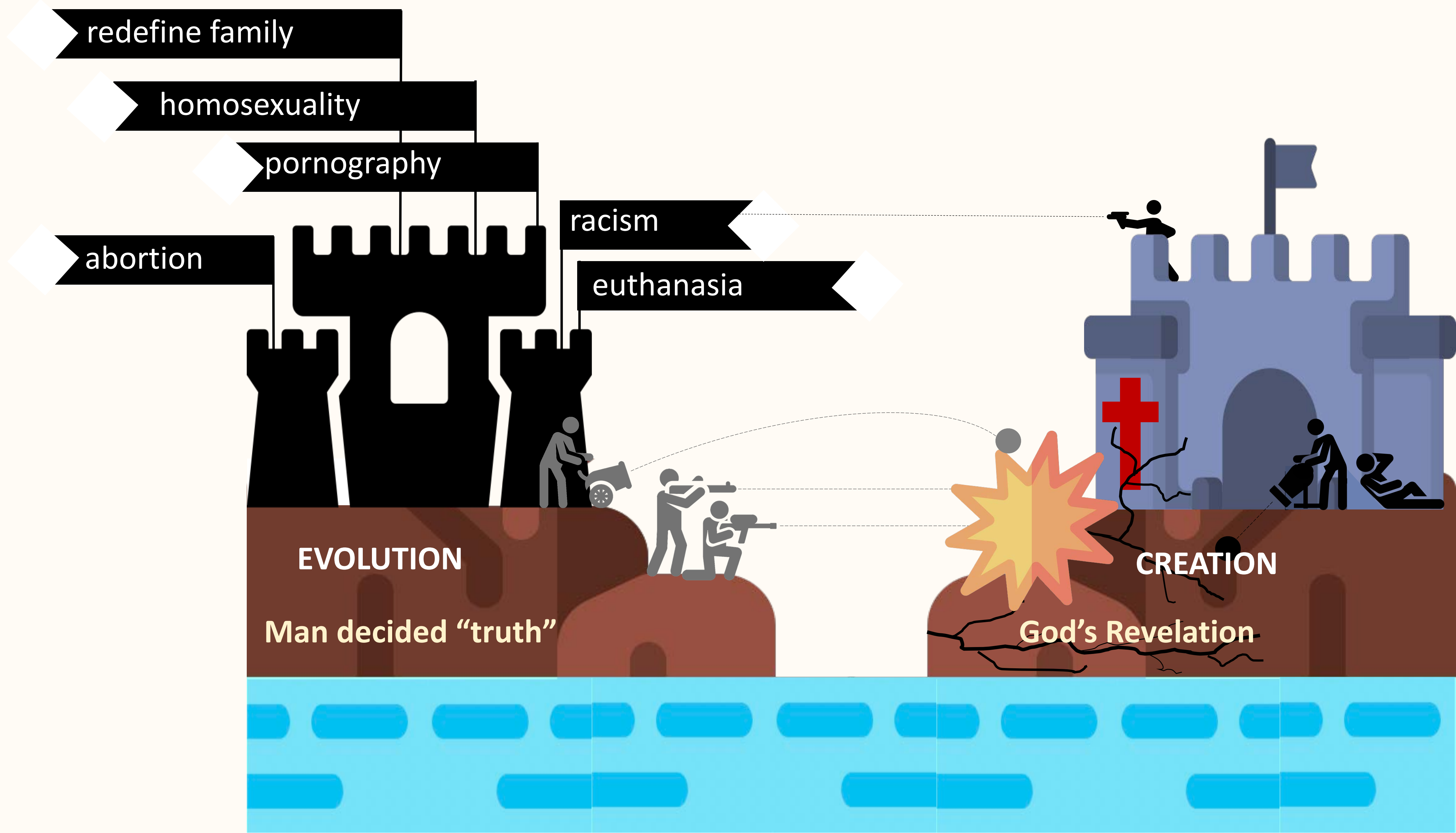
D. Decline in life span after the Flood
