





#### A. About the Covenants

Jews were expecting to fully occupy the Promised Land, to have a Son of David on the throne in Jerusalem and as a nation, have a new heart to love *Yahweh* forever.

#### **B.** About the Messiah


Jews were waiting for God to send the promised Savior.

#### C. About the Tribulation

Jews were expecting a time of great Tribulation for their people before God rescues them.

#### D. About the Coming Kingdom

Jews were eagerly waiting for all the amazing promises: world peace, Messiah and Prince David ruling from Jerusalem, Israel a superpower, great prosperity for all, no natural disasters and a renewed earth and nature.




#### Old Testament completed

400-year silence. God did not speak to the Jews. No prophets in operation.

~ 430 BC Last 3 Old Testament prophets, Haggai, Zechariah, and Malachi finish writing.

Malachi 4:5–6 (Last prophet of the Old Testament)

<sup>5</sup> "Look, I am sending you the prophet Elijah before the great and dreadful day of the LORD arrives. <sup>6</sup> His preaching will turn the hearts of fathers to their children, and the hearts of children to their fathers. Otherwise I will come and strike the land with a curse."


No other god except Yahweh






## Sabbath = Day of Rest

- what they could or could not do with their animals on that day!



## Second Temple (Herod's Upgrade)



Acts 7:48, "However, the Most High does not dwell in temples made with hands, as the prophet says:"


<u>Isa. 29:13</u>, "Therefore the Lord said: 'Inasmuch as these people draw near <u>with their mouths</u> and <u>honor Me with their lips</u>, but <u>have removed their hearts far from Me</u>, and <u>their fear toward Me</u> is taught by the commandment of men,' "

#### When Would Yahweh Send the Promised Savior?

- 1 Pet. 1:10, "Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the grace that would come to you,
- 1 Pet. 1:11, "searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow.
- 1 Pet. 1:12, "To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, but to us they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven—things which angels desire to look into."

Gal. 4:4, "But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, Gal. 4:5, "to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons."

Importantly, this renewal is God's work, not man's






## God's Revelation in Scripture:

Content-filled message given in human language so man can understand.





#### 2. Man

#### **Human reason**

because man's mind is able to discover truth without any external help (that is, without any god).





#### 3. Man

Man's personal experience and feelings are the ultimate source of truth. This includes scientific study.



## Yahweh Sent a Prophet to Announce the Arrival of the Messiah

John 1:29, "The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, 'Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!

John 1:30, "This is He of whom I said, "After me comes a Man who is preferred before me, for He was before me." "

John 1:31, "I did not know Him; but that He should be revealed to Israel, therefore I came baptizing with water."


John 1:32, "And John bore witness, saying, 'I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and He remained upon Him.

John 1:33, "I did not know Him, but He who sent me to baptize with water said to me, 'Upon whom you see the Spirit descending, and remaining on Him, this is He who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.'


John 1:34, "And I have seen and testified that this is the Son of God."



#### **Abrahamic Covenant**

Gen. 12:1, "Now the Lord had said to Abram: 'Get out of your country, from your family and from your father's house, to a <u>land</u> that I will show you.

Gen. 12:2, "'I will make you a great nation; I will bless you and make your name great; And you shall be a blessing.

Gen. 12:3, "'I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.'"

Rom. 3:1, "What advantage then has the Jew, or what is the profit of circumcision?

Rom. 3:2, "Much in every way! Chiefly because to them were committed the oracles of God."


Amos 3:7, "Surely the Lord GOD does nothing, unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets."

Ex. 19:5, "'Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine.

Matt. 28:19, "'Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, by baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

Matt. 28:20, " 'and by teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and look, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.' Amen."

John 1:10, "He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him.

John 1:11, "He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him."


## Why did the Jews Reject the Savior that Yahweh Sent?



Afraid of losing peace



Afraid of losing legalism



Wanted to protect their temple worship



Jesus was the "wrong" type of Messiah



They refused to believe that Messiah is Yahweh
