

Jesus focused on



The Pharisees' religious authority comes from "our age-old tradition" (verse 2).

Jesus rejects the authority of their traditions. True authority comes from God's Word alone (verse 3).

Matt. 21:8, "And a very great multitude spread their clothes on the road; others cut down branches from the trees and spread them on the road.

Matt. 21:9, "Then the multitudes who went before and those who followed cried out, saying: 'Hosanna to the Son of David! "Blessed is He who comes in the name of the LORD!" Hosanna in the highest!'

Matt. 21:10, "And when He had come into Jerusalem, all the city was moved, saying, 'Who is this?'

Matt. 21:11, "So the multitudes said, 'This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth of Galilee.'"

5. They refused to believe that the Messiah is Yahweh.

<u>Isa. 9:6</u>, "For unto us <u>a Child is born</u>, unto us <u>a Son</u> is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called <u>Wonderful</u>, Counselor, <u>Mighty God</u>, <u>Everlasting Father</u>, Prince of Peace."

Isa. 7:14, "Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel."

John 8:56, "'Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw it and was glad."

John 8:57, "Then the Jews said to Him, 'You are not yet fifty years old, and have You seen Abraham?'

John 8:58, "Jesus said to them, 'Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM.'

"I AM"


John 8:59, "Then they took up stones to throw at Him; but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by."

God's People in the New Testament


Most Jews rejected Jesus

Few Jewish believers

- Mark 8:16, "And they reasoned among themselves, saying, 'It is because we have no bread.'
- Mark 8:17, "But Jesus, being aware of it, said to them, 'Why do you reason because you have no bread? Do you not yet perceive nor understand? Is your heart still hardened?
- Mark 8:18, " 'Having eyes, do you not see? And having ears, do you not hear? And do you not remember?
- Mark 8:19, " 'When I broke the five loaves for the five thousand, how many baskets full of fragments did you take up?' They said to Him, 'Twelve.'
- Mark 8:20, "'Also, when I broke the seven for the four thousand, how many large baskets full of fragments did you take up?' And they said, 'Seven.'
- Mark 8:21, "So He said to them, 'How is it you do not understand?' "

Think ... don't you understand?






Mark 8:22, "Then He came to Bethsaida; and they brought a blind man to Him, and begged Him to touch him.

Mark 8:23, "So He took the blind man by the hand and led him out of the town. And when He had spit on his eyes and put His hands on him, He asked him if he saw anything.

Mark 8:24, "And he looked up and said, 'I see men like trees, walking."

Mark 8:25, "Then He put His hands on his eyes again and made him look up. And he was restored and saw everyone clearly."

Why Did Jesus do This Two-Step Miracle?



Mark 8:27, "Now Jesus and His disciples went out to the towns of Caesarea Philippi; and on the road He asked His disciples, saying to them, 'Who do men say that I am?'

Mark 8:28, "So they answered, 'John the Baptist; but some say, Elijah; and others, one of the prophets.'

Mark 8:29, "He said to them, 'But who do you say that I am?' Peter answered and said to Him, 'You are the Christ.'"

Other Jews also believed

1. When Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead.

John 12:17, "Therefore the people, who were with Him when He called Lazarus out of his tomb and raised him from the dead, bore witness. John 12:18, "For this reason the people also met Him, because they heard that He had done this sign.

John 12:19, "The Pharisees therefore said among themselves, 'You see that you are accomplishing nothing. Look, the world has gone after Him!"

2. When Peter the apostle preached his first public sermon.

Acts 2:38, "Then Peter said to them, 'Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 2:39, "For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call."

Acts 2:40, "And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, 'Be saved from this perverse generation.'

Acts 2:41, "Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them."

3. When Peter and John appeared before the Sanhedrin.

Acts 4:1, "Now as they spoke to the people, the priests, the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees came upon them,

Acts 4:2, "being greatly disturbed that they taught the people and preached in Jesus the resurrection from the dead.

Acts 4:3, "And they laid hands on them, and put them in custody until the next day, for it was already evening.

Acts 4:4, "However, many of those who heard the word believed; and the number of the men came to be about five thousand."

When the apostles performed miracles and preached about Jesus.

Acts 5:12, "And through the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were done among the people. And they were all with one accord in Solomon's Porch.

Acts 5:13, "Yet none of the rest dared join them, but the people esteemed them highly.

Acts 5:14, "And believers were increasingly added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women,"

Even Jesus' own brothers who did not believe in Him before, now believed.

John 7:2, "Now the Jews' Feast of Tabernacles was at hand.

John 7:3, "His brothers therefore said to Him, 'Depart from here and go into Judea, that Your disciples also may see the works that You are doing.

John 7:4, "'For no one does anything in secret while he himself seeks to be known openly. If You do these things, show Yourself to the world."

John 7:5, "For even His brothers did not believe in Him."

Acts 1:14, "These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers."

Matt. 15:24, "But He answered and said, 'I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel."


Matt. 15:25, "Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, 'Lord, help me!'

Matt. 15:26, "But He answered and said, 'It is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the little dogs."


Matt. 15:27, "And she said, 'Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table."






Through His work of creation, God made it obvious to mankind that He exists.

Acts 17:29, "Therefore, since we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Divine Nature is like gold or silver or stone, something shaped by art and man's devising.

Acts 17:30, "Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent,


